WHAT IS CARTEENS??

The 4-H CARTEENS program is a traffic safety educational program for teen traffic offenders. The purpose of this program is to increase traffic safety knowledge, and decrease the number of second time teen traffic offenders.

CARTEENS is a cooperative program conducted by Ohio State University Extension and Sandusky County Juvenile Court.

The unique quality of the CARTEENS program is that teens serve as the instructors and planners for the program.

The “CAR” in CARTEENS stands for “Cautious And Responsible.” The program covers topics including : speeding, seat belt use, driving distractions, impaired driving and other offenses. The program format utilizes speakers, group discussion and hands-on activities.



Program Guidelines

Please read all this information carefully.

- The 4-H CARTEENS program will be held on your assigned date. **Registration begins at 4:45 p.m. The session begins promptly at 5:00 p.m.** at which time the doors will be closed. Those arriving late will be considered absent and will not receive any court attendance credit.
- **Participants do NOT have to call and register.** You have already been pre-registered by the Court.
- **A non-refundable fee of \$40.00 CASH ONLY per court referred offender** will be collected at registration. Parents/Guardians are welcome to observe and will not be charged a fee.
- **Traffic offenders will not be permitted to leave before the entire class is completed.**
- **All cell phones and electronic devices must be turned off during the program.**
- **Respectable behavior is required** at all times during the session. Any youth and their parents/guardians exhibiting unruly, disrespectful or uncooperative behavior shall be removed from the session. Participants will then be reported and referred to the Sandusky County Juvenile Court for further action.
- The program location is a smoke-free building. **Smoking is not permitted.**
- If you have questions concerning access, wish to request a sign language interpreter or accommodations for a disability please contact Anita Moffett or Gwen Soule at 419-334-6340. Early requests are encouraged, for seamless access.
- If you cannot attend the meeting as scheduled, you should notify the court as soon as possible to determine your options.
- **Prior to the program date**—you may, with an appropriate reason, reschedule your 4-H CARTEENS program only one time. CARTEEN program dates can be found by contacting the OSU Extension Office or the Juvenile Court.
